Grüner Veltliner is a very popular variety grown throughout Austria and parts of Germany. The climate of the Leelanau Peninsula is similar to that of Germany and parts of Austria, which enables us to grow many of the same grape varieties. The Grüner variety produces a delicate dry white wine with aromas of melon and a hint of white pepper on the palate in the background. The palate of our Grüner Veltliner has a lovely minerality drawn from the terroir of the Leelanau Peninsula. This wine has balanced acidity and a nice clean, long finish.

**NOSE**

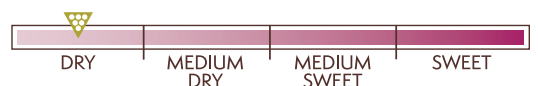
On the nose you will find aromas cantaloupe and wet beach stone.

**PALATE**

The palate of our Grüner Veltliner has a lovely minerality drawn from the natural springs that surround the vineyard. This wine has balanced acidity and a nice clean long finish. The wine is soft and subtle on the mid-palate with balanced acidity and a slightly zesty finish.
