Rosés have such a variety because they can be produced from such a large variety of red grapes and can also be blends of white grapes and red grapes. There are no two roses that are alike, which requires consumers to continue to explore new rosés from all parts of the world every year. Our 2016 Pinot Noir Rosé is a lighter style rose with elegant acidity. The fruit was monitored daily leading up to harvest to make sure it was harvested when the phenolics were to the wine makers specification. This rosé is best served chilled and can be paired with a wide variety of cuisine from around the world.

NOSE

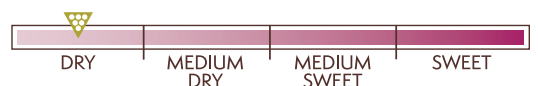
Slightly under ripe strawberries and perfectly ripe cherries fill the glass.

PALATE

The cherry aroma follows through on the palate along with a mineral component derived from the soil of the site where the fruit is grown on the Peninsula. This rose has a light to medium body with a medium finish and a bright acidity allowing you to pair the wine with richer food or bright light salads and pastas.
