2012 chardonnay

Much like Pinot Grigio and Riesling, Chardonnay is a variety that thrives on the Leelanau Peninsula. Given the right combination of sunlight, heat, and rain, the Leelanau Peninsula can produce some world class still Chardonnay wines. The 2012 vintage has slight tropical aromas followed by stronger floral notes. This Chardonnay is lightly oaked simply to round out the finish and help boost the mouth-feel.

NOSE

At first, you may smell hints of tropical fruits such as banana and papaya, however, linger and you will begin to experience the lovely floral aromas toward the end.

PALATE

Big, red delicious apple will cover your palate. The 2012 Chardonnay has a lush mouth-feel with bright balanced acidity on the end. The used French Oak is present but only in the mouth-feel, not on the nose or on the long elegant finish.
