2017 PINOT NOIR ROSÉ

LEELANAU PENINSULA | DRY WHITE WINE

Rosés of all types are perfect additions to any warm climate occasion. While they are typically consumed in the summer months, they can be enjoyed all year. Rosés offer consumers an additional category to explore and learn. Rosés provide unique aromatics and flavors from their still red counterparts that make the category interesting and attractive to oenophiles. The Leelanau Peninsula is an ideal place to produce high aromatic, crisp, dry roses. Our growing season, and the varieties that are able to be grown are ideal for rosé production.

NOSE

The 2017 Pinot Noir Rosé has a distinct nose of red cherries and blood orange followed by hints of rose petal.

PALATE

On the palate you will encounter flavors of strawberries, orange zest, and light notes of vanilla. The wine has a lush mouthfeel with a smooth long finish complimented by balanced acid making this wine a great wine to pair with charcuterie, fresh salads, and seafood.
